Make decisions	Present oneself in an appropriate manner while in uniform and at all NL Cadet activities
Use the law	Wear and maintain the uniform and equipment in your possession
Feel safe	Actively participate during lessons
Learn	Participate in NL branch fundraising endeavours
Be heard	Perform duties as they are assigned
Say “NO” to unwelcome behaviour	
Be protected from all forms of abuse and harassment

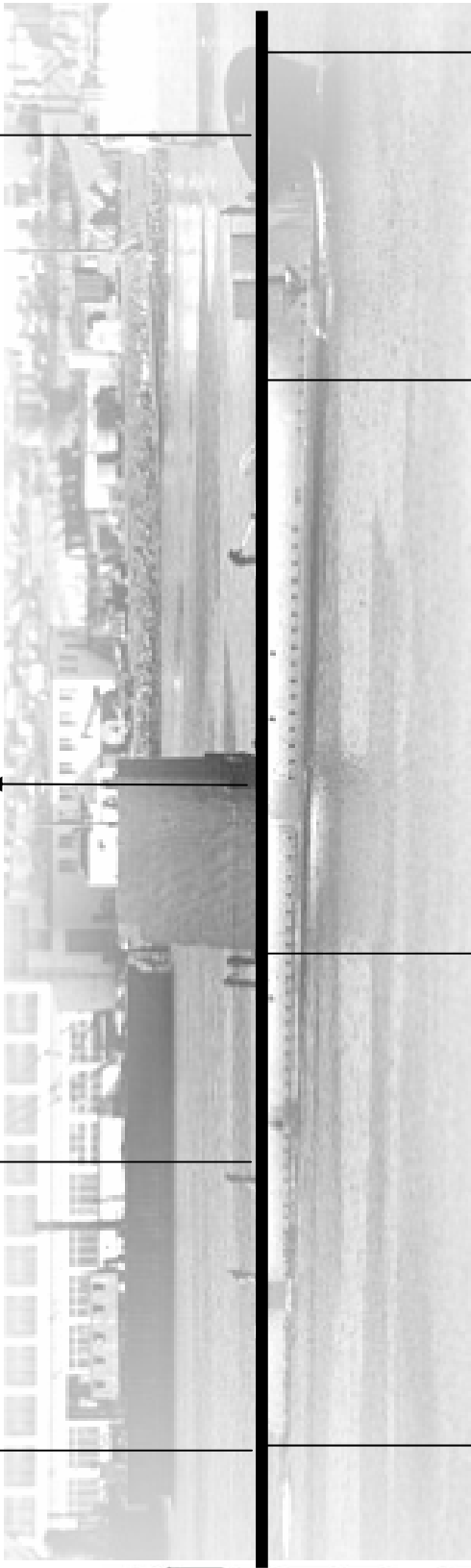
