## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

The Navy League of Canada awards scholarships annually to serving Royal Canadian Sea Cadets entering the first year of University or Community College course leading to a degree or diploma.

The amount of the scholarship varies with the type of institution selected and also is dependent on availability of funds. The value of the scholarship will be made payable to the institute being attended.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Personal letter of application from candidate including information on the name and location of the University or College to be attended and the course of the study to be taken (NL (31) E).
2. Original certificate, or certified copy thereof, as issued by the responsible educational authorities, which records midterm examination results, by subjects, upon which admission to University or College is based (certificates will be returned.)

When final marks for the school year are not available until August, mid-year marks must be submitted at an earlier date for preliminary consideration

3. Letter from Commanding Officer of Corps attended by candidate, including proof that the candidate was Royal Canadian Sea Cadet in good standing for at least 24 months; the name and location of the Corps and recommendations on the candidate.
4. Recommendation of Branch President responsible for Corps.
5. Recommendation of Division President responsible for Corps.

### **APPLICATION:**

Application to be submitted through the Navy League Branch responsible for the Corps of which the candidate is a member, to the responsible Division, then to the National Office, The Navy League of Canada.

Applications and all supporting documents (including mid-term marks) must be received at the National Office on or before **June 30<sup>th</sup>**. Final marks must be received at the National Office on or before **August 15<sup>th</sup>**. Adjudication will be completed and all candidates advised by the first week of September.
